

#### **Grant originated in the 87th Texas Legislature**

- The authorization of the grant comes from <u>House Bill 1525</u> and Rider 69 (included in <u>Senate Bill 1</u>). House Bill 1525 amends Texas Education Code, §29.026.
- \$70 million was appropriated for this grant with \$35 million for each of two years.
  - 2022-2023 and 2023-2024





#### Who is eligible to apply?

- All Texas local education agencies (LEAs) are eligible to apply for grant funding.
- LEAs may apply individually or in collaboration with other districts or open-enrollment charter schools. Prioritization of funding is given to collaborative applications.





#### **Purpose of the Grant**



To increase the LEA's capacity to implement innovative programs that effectively serve students with autism ages three through 21.



To result in effective, scalable models that can be replicated in other areas of the state.

## To be eligible for a grant award, the LEA's application must incorporate:

- Evidence-based practices
- Data collection on student achievement and improvement
- Parental support and collaboration
- Use of technology, which may include interactive technology
- Meaningful inclusion
- Ability to replicate the program for students statewide







#### General list of allowable expenses for grant include but not limited to:

Salaries for dedicated staff

Professional or contracted services

Capital outlay and equipment

Instructional resources, curriculum development, and materials

Technology

Interpreter or translation for services for parent training

#### **Grant application dates**



Grant application opens on February 1, 2022.



Grant application **closes** on **March 18, 2022**.





Additional grant details will be available on **February 1, 2022**, when the grant application opens.







#### March 31 – April 11, 2022

- If funds are available after all eligible applications are reviewed, LEAs may resubmit applications that need revision in order to be eligible for funding.
- Assistance will be provided to these LEAs.
- The LEA will be notified by March 30, 2022, that resubmission is an option.








